



CRISIS MANAGEMENT TEAM TRAINING

GOAL:

Crises can cause major disruption to the normal course of business operations. They usually occur suddenly and unexpectedly, often pose a risk to life and limb, and can lead to considerable financial losses and damage to a firm's reputation. Nowadays, it is not only force majeure, fire, and theft that threaten companies. The dangers and associated risks are extremely varied and are exacerbated by the global nature of today's economy (which facilitates the spread of pandemics, for example).

In the context of business continuity management (BCM), companies make preparations to minimize these risks and thus remain capable of action. An important part of BCM for any business is crisis management, which covers processes for overcoming an emergency situation and getting up and running again, thus safeguarding the company's existence. Setting up a crisis management team and ensuring that it is capable of working effectively are the building blocks on which a successful crisis management concept must be based, and these measures can only be properly implemented by means of regular training.

In the majority of companies the training opportunities for members of a crisis or emergency management team are limited. The requisite expertise and internal resources are often lacking. That is why it makes sense to carry out such training with the help of external specialists.
